Site Secures New Training Agreement

Site Group International Limited ("Site", ASX:SIT) has signed a landmark Training Services Agreement with HYTORC Division, UNEX Corporation ("HYTORC"), the market leader in precision industrial bolting systems.

The Agreement is for the delivery of The American Society of Mechanical Engineers ("ASME") Qualified Bolting Specialist training and other engineer and craftsman bolting courses in locations where Site has operations or is developing facilities in the Asia Pacific Region and Australia.

HYTORC has more than 40 years' experience in industrial bolting and is focused entirely on industrial torque and tension systems. HYTORC has developed solutions for nearly every bolting application from steel mills and mining equipment to refineries, nuclear power plants and wind turbines.
